## Checking your connection strength

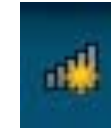
if you are finding that you are not getting connection to the internet or that you're internet browsing is slow, then there are a few things that you may want to check. On the Taskbar you will find you're wireless strength indicator

## What do they Mean?

To the Right you will see the three types of indicators that you may get and there meanings



**The Available indicator** shows that there are Networks available for you to connect to



**No Networks/Disconnected Indicator** that there are **no** Networks Available



**Connected indicator** shows that you have a solid connection to a network

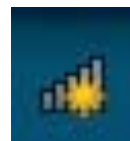
## Disconnected

If you see this indicator then you will not have Internet access, **To Resolve this** you need to switch on the wireless device next to the power Button you will see a green



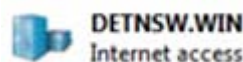
On the front of the Net book you will also notice two bright blue lights when the above has been done

## Available

Clicking on this Indicator will prompt you to choose your network you will only be able to connect to **nswdet**. Then wait approx 1-2 Min and you will be connected. You will know when you have full connection when you see the Image Below in the top section.
